ORDER OF SUSPENSION OF TRADING

It appears to the Securities and Exchange Commission that there is a lack of current and accurate public information concerning the securities of Rivex Technology Corp. (CIK No. 0001702541) because of questions since at least November 4, 2019 regarding (i) the accuracy and adequacy of publicly available information in the marketplace about the company; (ii) recent, unusual, unexplained market activity. Rivex Technology Corp. is a Nevada Corporation whose current principal place of business is in Kalispel, Montana. As of January 8, 2020, RIVX's common stock was quoted on OTC Link operated by OTC Markets Group Inc. (formerly "Pink Sheets") ("OTC Link"), had twelve market makers, and was eligible for the "piggyback" exception of Exchange Act Rule 15c2-11(f)(3).

The Commission is of the opinion that the public interest and the protection of investors require a suspension of trading in the securities of the above-listed company.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to Section 12(k) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, that trading in the securities of the above-listed companies is suspended for the period from 9:30 a.m. EST on January 9, 2020, through 11:59 p.m. EST on January 23, 2020. By the Commission.
